

OC9 Google Sheets Auto Logging

Automated Weekly Performance Reporting Guide

Optional advanced reporting integration for automated OC9 performance tracking using Google Sheets.

HOW IT WORKS

OC9 can automatically send weekly performance summaries to your own private Google Sheet using a lightweight Google Apps Script connection.

This allows users to track long-term operational performance, weekly ROI, transparency metrics, and runtime observations outside the OC9 application.

OC9 → Google Apps Script → Google Sheets

WHAT YOU NEED

- Google account
- Computer or laptop
- 2–5 minutes setup time
- OC9 already installed

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Completely optional feature
- No coding knowledge required
- Your spreadsheet stays inside your own Google account
- Does NOT affect OC9 trading execution

STEP 1 — CREATE YOUR PRIVATE SHEET COPY

Open the official OC9 Google Sheet template and create your own private copy.

- Click: Make a Copy
- Save the spreadsheet into your Google Drive

- The Apps Script will copy automatically

Google may display a warning explaining that the Apps Script will also be copied. This is expected and required for automated logging.

STEP 2 — OPEN GOOGLE APPS SCRIPT

- Inside Google Sheets open: Extensions → Apps Script
- Wait for the Apps Script editor to load
- Do not modify the provided code

STEP 3 — DEPLOY THE SCRIPT

- Click: Deploy → Manage Deployments
- Click the pencil edit icon
- Click Deploy
- Approve Google authorization prompts if requested

Google may warn that the application is unverified. This is normal because the script belongs to your own Google account.

STEP 4 — COPY THE WEB APP URL

After deployment completes, Google will generate a Web App URL.

- Copy the Web App URL
- Keep this URL private
- This URL connects OC9 to your spreadsheet

STEP 5 — CONNECT TO OC9

Inside the OC9 application:

Settings → Google Sheets Logging

- Paste your Web App URL
- Enable Logging
- Save Settings





WHAT GETS TRACKED

- ✓ Weekly account value
- ✓ Net profit and ROI
- ✓ Trade totals
- ✓ Win/loss ratios
- ✓ Performance summaries
- ✓ Long-term operational history

SAFETY & PRIVACY

Google Sheets logging is completely optional and does not impact trading execution or operational runtime.

Your spreadsheet data remains stored inside your own Google account.

-  OC9 does NOT access your Google password
-  OC9 does NOT read personal Google Drive files
-  OC9 does NOT control your Google account
-  OC9 does NOT affect exchange execution behavior

RECOMMENDED USAGE

- ✓ Review reports weekly
- ✓ Track long-term trends instead of short-term fluctuations
- ✓ Avoid emotional overreaction to small drawdowns
- ✓ Use reports for transparency and observation

FUTURE EXPANSION

Future OC9 reporting systems may include advanced dashboards, drawdown analytics, multi-account summaries, public sharing tools, and expanded operational transparency systems.
